The Polish Society for Medical Hygiene is non-governmental organization dedicated to infection prevention in medical institutions. The PSMH is registered in Poland since 1997 with 350 members in 2016. Members are medical doctors, epidemiology nurses, microbiologists, sanitary inspection officers.

Each year we organize 3-4 scientific conferences, 2 special courses for physicians and 2 special courses for nurses and 20 workshops in hospitals.

In 2016 we have organized 3 conferences: "Infection control in ophthalmology" (April, Warsaw), National Infection Prevention Forum (June, Warsaw), Annual Scientific Conference (October, St. Jablonki).

In 2017 we will celebrate 20th Anniversary with 4 conferences in January, April, June and October.

We are involved in scientific projects, legislative work with governmental institutions and hospital accreditation process.

We started cooperation with Ukrainian Association for Infection Control and Antimicrobial Resistance.
