IPS Journal The Journal of Infection Prevention is the professional journal of the Infection Prevention Society. We have made considerable progress in developing the format and content of the journal in the last 2 years and recently have been successful in our application to be included in PubMed Central. This means that articles published in JIP will be far more readily discoverable Internationally and PMC will be indexing all JIP papers published since January 2014.

OneTogether is a partnership of professional organizations, including IPS, who are working together to promote and support the adoption of best practice to prevent surgical site infection (SSI). We have developed, tested and launched a self-assessment tool and scorecard to evaluate compliance with evidence-based practice for SSI prevention in seven areas of care across the surgical pathway. This tool, together with a data capture and reporting spreadsheet, has been made freely available.

Torch Tour

The event began on 5th May to coincide with the WHO 'See Your Hands' campaign and will finish on 26th September 2016 at the first day of Infection Prevention 2016 Conference in Harrogate. The Torch Tour has the support of the IPS Patron Prof Didier Pittet - Director of the Infection Control Programme and WHO Collaborating Centre on Patient Safety.

The aims of the Hand Hygiene Torch Tour were to:

- Partner with other healthcare infection and patient organisations to highlight the annual World Health Organisation 'Clean Your Hands - Call to Action' for healthcare workers.

Each IPS Branch is planning local events to coincide with the Torch's arrival. These events will be public facing and may include:

- Local fetes or county shows,
- Sports events

The torch will also travel with the IPS Board members to international meetings during the torch tour period including IPAAC (Canada), APIC (USA) and ICNJ (Japan).
