The European Committee for Standardization (CEN) and the European Committee for Electrotechnical Standardization (CENELEC) are two officially recognised organisations (EU Regulation 1025/2012) responsible for developing standards at European level .The members of CEN and CENELEC are the National Standards Bodies of 33 European countries including all of the EU member states plus Iceland, Norway, Switzerland, Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia and Turkey. CEN and CENELEC also work to promote the international harmonisation of standards in the framework of technical cooperation agreements with ISO (International Organization for Standardization) and IEC (International Electrotechnical Commission).

Ebola viral disease (EVD) is a severe and life-threatening disease with 90% mortality rate. The current Ebola outbreak in West Africa entered its second year and is unprecedented because it is the largest one in history, involved urban centers and affected a large number of health care workers. Bulgarian Association for Prevention and Infection Control (BAPIC) “BulNoso” was established as NGO in 2003 with the substantial support of Bulgarian-Swiss Hospital Hygiene Programme-BSHHP (bilateral collaborative initiative of Bulgarian Ministry of Health and Swiss Agency for development and international collaboration).

In the same year BulNoso joined IFIC as a Member society and since then has become part of many basic activities of IFIC: our specialists attended annual congresses and published articles in IJIC. As of 2015, BulNoso membership shows an upward trend: from 13 founders up to 594 individual members and 35 corporate members (hospitals).
