#### **Link doctor**

At least one per hospital

Senior staff member

In bigger hospitals more, eg for risk departments (hematologyoncology, internal ICU, surgery with ICU, neurosurgery, pediatrics)

Training according to respective society

German Society of Hospital Hygiene: 40 hours course

Some hours paid leave of absence recommended



#### **Link doctor**

Tasks, eg
link between hospital hygiene and department member of hygiene commission member of working groups co-writer of standards of department engagement in hygienic training engaged in outcome surveillance antibiotic policy outbreak management



#### Link nurse

One per ward and units like physiotherapy, endoscopy, radiology

Experienced nurse

German Society of Hospital Hygiene: 40 hours course



#### Link nurse

Tasks, eg
link between hospital hygiene and department
training in ward
member of working groups and quality groups
co-writer of standards of care
outbreak management



### **Experience**

Nurses very engaged, most have training

Few doctors engaged

Engagement might increase because of growing importance of hygiene in Germany

Own experience since 10 years:

80 nurses: at least 60 % active

20 doctors: up to 20 % active
