Infection prevention department in each hospital. In the majority of hospitals this is part of the medical microbiology department, in some it is part of the quality improvement department.

They report to the infection control comity that should be present in each hospital.

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## INFECTION CONTROL RESOURCE CAPACITY IN ACUTE HOSPITALS



### **Professionals' background**

Microbiology or infectious disease for infection control doctors, qualified nurses or laboratory technician (medical microbiology) or other (preferably) healthcare associated education/training (bachelor).

#### **Recommended ratios or other measures:**

- 1 IC doctor / 25.000 admissions
- 1 IC nurse / 5.000 admissions

1 fte ICP: 1/250 Beds

1 medical microbiologist/epidemiologist: 1/ 1000 Beds

1 fte ICP per 5000 Admissions (1 / 178 hospital beds)

>40% old standard(1/250 Beds)

1 medical microbiologist/epidemiologist per 25000 Admissions

(1 / 856 hospital beds)

>17% old standard (1/ 1000 Beds)
